- **Project Management Office**

Region 3 PMO roles and resources include:

- Project management best practices framework specifically applied to Waiver 1115 programs; framework will offer a system/structure to help ensure process milestones, improvement milestones, and outcome measures are achieved. This will primarily be accomplished by ensuring accurate tracking of program metrics and linking those metrics to relevant milestone bundles, outcomes and thus improvement targets.
- Online tracking software and support for start to finish documentation of Waiver 1115 programs.
- Online tracking software and support for "sub-project" mechanics to strengthen likelihood required "infrastructure projects" are on-time, within budget, and meet identified scope. (ie. Bricks and mortar sub-project build out required to implement expanded access to primary care.)
- Regional timeline overview of DY with regard to project management. (Ongoing)
- Technical (data submission) support on state reporting requirements.
- When requested, onsite training and support for both framework and tracking software.
- Pre-population of tracking software with Waiver 1115 plans and project management implementation plans (based on submission of Project Management Implementation Form) for each project.
- Training on public dashboard creation (dashboards will be published to SETRHP website) to ensure transparency goals are achieved.

- **Project Management Software**

- Harris Health is in the final purchasing phase of a comprehensive online software tool that will provide an efficient way to organize and manage complex projects from start to finish. Deployment is expected to begin no later than May 1, 2013. Training materials will be available no later than mid-June. At a minimum, the software tool will specifically provide:
 - Both high-level and granular project management time, task and dependency tracking;
 - Ability for each performing provider to create and administer their own teams, sub-projects, task assignment and completion, Gantt Charts, calendars, risk analysis, and document management;
 - A vehicle for single point of project team communication and collaboration tools;
 - High-level reporting dashboard creation;
 - Program milestones, metrics and outcome measure tracking and illustration; and
 - Technical data submission support.
