Title: The Ambulatory Surgical Center (ASC) at LBJ			
Scope of Care	The Ambulatory Surgical Center (ASC) at LBJ Hospital provides high-quality, patient-centered surgical care in an outpatient setting. The ASC includes 5 operating rooms designed to support a wide range of elective surgical procedures. The nursing staff delivers care during the preoperative, intraoperative, and postoperative phases; all collaboration is aimed at ensuring continuity and safety.		
Patient Population Served	The ASC serves pediatric, adult, and geriatric patients who are scheduled for elective outpatient surgical or procedural interventions. Patients are discharged the same day following recovery.		
Criteria for Admission	Patients are admitted based on scheduled, elective surgical procedures that are appropriate for an outpatient setting. Patients must meet preoperative screening criteria to ensure they are medically stable for sameday surgery.		
Procedures/Treatments Provided	Surgical specialties supported at the ASC include general surgery, orthopedics, ophthalmology, otorhinolaryngology (ENT), urology, gynecology, plastics, and oral maxillofacial surgery. Procedures are selected based on their suitability for outpatient care.		
Hours of Operation	The ASC operates Monday through Friday, during scheduled daytime hours. Monday to Friday: 0600-1900		
Leadership	The ASC is led by a Director of Nursing with operational responsibility 24/7 and has overall accountability for the strategic, operational, human resource, quality, and financial management of the service. The leadership team includes Nurse Managers (PACU/Pre-OP and Operating Room) and Charge Nurses who oversee daily operations, staffing, and clinical decision-making. The ASC reports to the Administrator, ASC at LBJ.		
Unit Governance	Shared governance is based upon a Community of Practice model, led by a unit-based clinician board and facilitated by a member of the leadership team. The clinician board members are responsible for engaging specified groups of nurses in two-way dialogue concerning professional practice and patient care issues, resulting in shared decision making.		

Staffing Skill Mix/ Qualifications

Staffing is based on national benchmarks, patient acuity, and historical volume. The team includes registered nurses, certified surgical technologists, and unlicensed assistive personnel. All staff complete department-specific competencies during orientation and annually.

New graduate nurses participate in a structured residency program. Health Unit Coordinators provide clerical support. Interpreter services are available in-person and via dual-handset or portable devices to support patients with limited English proficiency.

Scope of Services Students The ASC supports the Harris Health mission to educate future healthcare professionals. Nursing and surgical technologist students from local institutions complete clinical rotations under the guidance of experienced preceptors. **Approved Certifications** Certification is strongly encouraged. Recognized certifications include, but are not limited: 1. Certified Nurse Operating Room (CNOR) Certified Surgical Technologist (CST) through AST or NBSTSA 3. Certified Ambulatory Perianesthesia Nurse (CAPA). 4. Certified Post Anesthesia Nurse (CPAN). 5. Nurse Executive and Nurse Executive Advanced - Board Certified (NE-BC and NEA-BC) 6. Certified Anesthesia Technician (Cer.A.T) 7. Certified Registered Central Service Technician (CRCST) 8. Certified Instrument Specialist (CIS) 9. Certified Endoscope Reprocessor (CER) Plan for Modifying Staffing to Meet Patient or Staffing adjustments are made based on surgical volume and patient **Process Needs** acuity. Options include voluntary overtime, use of the Nursing Registry, and leadership support in clinical roles. Shift huddles are conducted to assess and optimize staffing resources.

Assessment and Reassessment Practices and Timeframes

Patients are assessed in the Pre-Operative Holding Area prior to surgery. Continuous reassessment is performed throughout the procedure by the surgical and anesthesia teams to ensure patient safety and optimal outcomes.
