	Dr. Kevin Erickson, Medical Director, HHDC, an update on the Baxter plant following Hurricane Helene and its impact on Harris Health and the pharmaceutical industry. He noted that these issues have since been resolved, allowing a return to the prescribed three-times-a-week dialysis schedule. He noted that HHDC is collaborating with the End Stage Renal Disease Network of Texas, Inc. (ESRD Network of Texas) to address hospitalizations. Dr. Lori Timmons, Director, Ambulatory Nursing, shared that HHDC shared that DC submitted a poster presentation on the peritoneal dialysis program to America's Essential Hospital Vital 2025, and it was selected. Dr. Cody Pyke recommended presenting the poster presentation to the DC Governing Body and/or full Board to highlight the outstanding work being done at the Dialysis Center.
