She emphasized that the medical staff has been focused on completing their Cybersecurity and Clinical Research trainings. Dr. Kunal Sharma, Vice Chair, Medical Executive Board, delivered an update from the previous Medical Executive Board meetings. He touched on continued efforts to address staffing challenges and revisions to the Medical Staff Bylaws. Dr. Caracostis inquired regarding Harris Health's credentialing process related to the frequency in which providers are checked against national databases. Ms. Carolynn Jones, Chief Compliance Officer, stated that Harris Health consistently checks various databases such as the Texas Medical Board and the National Practitioner Data Bank for issues relating to practitioner licenses and also checks the Electronic Incident Reporting System (eiRS) for any quality concerns. Ms. Jones stated that if any concerns arise, those concerns will be brought to the medical staff office.

Harris Health System Board of Trustees Joint Conference Committee Charter

The Joint Conference Committee shall comprise up to thirteen (13) voting members including members of the Board of Trustees ("Board"), the Medical Staff, the Chair of the Medical Executive Board ("MEB"), the Vice Chair of the MEB, the CEO and such other members of Harris Health Administration as appointed by the Board Chair and approved by the Board. The Chair of the Board shall be an ex-officio, non-voting member of the Committee. The Board Chair shall designate the Committee Chair.

The purpose of the Committee is to provide direct consultation between the Medical Staff and the Board, to ensure the delivery of high-quality health services.

The Committee shall meet at least four (4) times per year. The meetings of the Joint Conference Committee are not required to follow the Texas Open Meetings Act, unless the number of Health Board members participating in the meeting requires Compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act.

The Committee shall either meet in person or via a telecommunications system permitting immediate, synchronous communication.

The Committee shall:

- a. Serve as the venue for continuing discussion between the Board and the Medical Staff, to include discussion of matters related to the quality of medical care provided to Harris Health patients;
- b. Discuss Medical Staff engagement and make recommendations to the Board, as appropriate, regarding same;
- c. Review and make recommendations to the Board regarding changes to the Medical Staff Bylaws and Rules and Regulations.

The Committee Chair or the Board Chair may identify additional topics for discussion as issues arise and assign them to the Committee for discussion and consideration.
