The six Same Day Clinics opened by Harris Health through the 1115 Waiver have been a major success. This new service line has allowed Harris Health to expand capacity through adult focused primary care visits. All six Same Day clinics are open in their permanent locations. The six clinic locations include: Monroe, Robindell, Sunset Heights, Ben Taub, Sareen and Margo Hilliard Alford. CLICK HERE for addresses.

All six Same Day clinics have seen approximately 27,000 patients in DY4 to date. We have also partnered a Medical Screening Exam (MSE) Project that will further help screen patients from our Emergency Centers (Ben Taub and LBJ), to help guide those non-emergent cases to the Same Day clinics so that they can get the care they need in an expedited manner. Providing increased access demonstrates Harris Health's commitment to transforming healthcare and improving lives.

May 20, 2015, 5:00 p.m. - Due date for IGT Entities to notify HHSC of any issues with their affiliated providers' April DY4 reports.

June 10, 2015 - HHSC and CMS will complete their review and approval of April reports or request additional information (referred to as NMI) regarding the data reported.

July 2, 2015, 11:59 p.m. - Due date for providers to submit responses to HHSC requests for additional information on April reported milestone/metric achievement and incomplete semi-annual progress reports.

July 8, 2015 - IGT due for April reporting DSRIP payments and Monitoring IGT.

July 9, 2015 - Webinar - Care Transitions: HIE Integration (contact: RHP1O Meredith Oney: RHP Region 10@jpshealth.org).

July 17, 2015 - Category 3 Work Session (contact: Susan Seidensticker: smseiden@utmb.edu).

July 21, 2015 - April reporting DY4 DSRIP payments processed for transferring hospitals and top 14 IGT entities.

July 24, 2015 - IGT due for Anchor Administrative Cost Claiming.

July 31, 2015 - April reporting DY2 and DY3 DSRIP payments processed for all providers and DY4 DSRIP payments processed for remaining providers that were not paid on July 21.

Late July - HHSC to host a public hearing on the upcoming Waiver Renewal Application.

August 7, 2015 - HHSC and CMS will approve or deny the additional information submitted in response to HHSC comments on April reported milestone/metric achievement and semi-annual progress reports.

August 26th and 27th , 2015 - Statewide Learning Collaborative.

October 31, 2015 - DY4 DSRIP Reporting due.
