I.	Call to Order and Record of Attendance	Dr. Andrea Caracostis, Chair, called the meeting to order at 8:01 a.m. It was noted that a quorum was present and the attendance was recorded. Dr. Caracostis announced that while some board members are in the room, others will participate by videoconference as permissible by state law and the Harris Health Videoconferencing Policy. Only participants scheduled to speak have been provided dial in information for the meeting. II.	Approval of the Minutes of Previous Meeting Quality Committee Meeting — March 8, 2022		Moved by Ms. Elena Marks, seconded by Dr. Arthur Bracey, and unanimously approved the minutes of the March 8, 2022 Committee meeting.	
III.	Update Regarding Harris Health Correctional Health Quality	Dr. Otis Egins, Chief Medical Officer, Correctional Health, presented an update regarding Harris Health Correctional Health Quality. He emphasized that the continuous quality improvement program provides the opportunity to monitor and improve healthcare delivery. He reported that there have been technical obstacles to integrating Epic with other necessary systems, but it is a work in progress. The Correctional Health team plans to use a Quality of Care dashboard based on state and national standards for correctional health. Dr. Egins identified the first three (3) chronic diseases that will be tracked on the dashboard, which include diabetes, hypertensions, and HIV/AIDS.	As reported.

	He also reviewed the specific measures that will monitored and stated that he plans to report data on the aforementioned chronic diseases at the next Quality Committee meeting. Discussion ensued regarding addiction management, behavioral health management, and length of stay of patients in the jail. Dr. Egins reported that the current length of stay is an average of 287 days, which is significantly longer than normal but attributed it to the backlog in the courts.
