1.	Call to Order and Record of Attendance	Dr. Arthur Bracey, Presiding Chair, called the meeting to order at 7:33 a.m. It was noted that a quorum was present and the attendance was recorded. 11.	Approval of the Minutes of Previous Meeting Quality Committee Meeting – May 10, 2022		Moved by Ms. Elena Marks, seconded by Ms. Alicia Reyes, and unanimously approved the minutes of the previous meeting.
111.	Harris Health Safety Message	Dr. Steven Brass, Executive Vice President & Chief Medical Executive, shared a Minute for Medicine video series focused on fall prevention in the hospital.	
IV.	Update Regarding DNV Re- accreditation Survey Summary	Ms. Vivian Ho-Nguyen, Administrative Director, Accreditation & Regulatory Affairs, delivered an update regarding Det Norske Veritas (DNV) accreditation survey. The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) approved DNV as a national accrediting organization with deeming authority to access hospitals' compliance with the Medicare Conditions of Participation (CoPs). Ms. Ho-Nguyen stated that DNV conducts annual surveys as part of a 3 – year accreditation cycle, which provides structure and framework for a more robust Quality Assurance and Performance Improvement (QAPI) program. She expressed her thanks to the Survey Support Team, executive leadership, and the Survey Readiness Subcommittee of the Executive Corporate Compliance Committee.	As Presented.

	<ul> <li>Ms. Ho-Nguyen highlighted several noteworthy efforts some of which includes: <ul> <li>The culture of staff commitment to patient safety and the mission of Harris Health System is embedded in staff's DNA and their "muscle memory"</li> <li>Cutting edge technology; Cutting edge patient care and management processes; Exceptional services offered to the residents of Harris County</li> </ul> </li> <li>Ms. Ho-Nguyen reported that Harris Health closed on all six (6) findings from 2021 and that the survey team found seven (7) non-conformities, which they noted is a very successful survey result for an organization of our size. V. Consideration of Recommendation for Approval of the 2022 Harris Health Quality Manual	Mr. Joseph Kunisch, Vice President, Quality Programs, delivered a brief overview of the 2022 Harris Health Quality Manual. He mentioned that the updates to the manual include refining the Plan Do Act Check (PDCA) approach by leveraging Lean Six Sigma (LSS) Methodology; defined the Harris Health System Balanced Score Card including updates in the analytics and use of the performance metrics; and defined the quality related information workflow through the performance improvement framework inclusive of Key Performance Indicators (KPI) reported to the Pavilion Quality Review Councils (QRC), Quality Governance Council (QGC), Quality Board of Trustees (QBoT) and Harris Health Board of Trustees. A copy of the 2022 Harris Health Quality Manal is available in the permanent record. VI. Consideration of Recommendation for Approval of the 2022 Harris Health Patient Safety Plan	The 2022 Harris Health Safety Plan include updates to the definition of Serious Safety Event as well as an update to the Patient Safety Event Determination Algorithm. Additionally, the Level of Harm descriptions were updated to reflect the verbiage in the National Coordinating Council for Medication Error Reporting and Prevention (NCCMERP) Index for Categorizing Errors. This is the scoring strategy used, however the descriptions of the scores were not verbatim from the tool in the previous plan. A copy of the 2022 Harris Health Patient Safety Plan is available in the permanent record.
